Women in Mbale, Uganda's Abayudayan (Jewish) Community

Since 2011, Cleveland based non-profit Drink Local Drink Tap, has been building sustainable, safe water projects for water-poor people in Uganda. After working in Uganda for a few years, we met leaders in a Jewish area of Uganda near the boarder of Kenya and began designing water projects with their community. Mbale is a highly populated area with a town and villages miles from any treated clean source. Drought has made getting water even more difficult in the last few years.

Drink Local Drink Tap has started selling Ugandan-made Kippot to support local, Jewish female owned businesses and to support building DLDT water and sanitation projects. Kippot can be ordered one by one or in bulk. Please see pricing below and note orders will be need to follow the schedule below.
